

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF STREET SUPERINTENDENT FOR THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the public welfare can best be realized by the establishment of the office of Street Superintendent,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Highland, Arkansas:

Section 1. The office Street Superintendent is hereby established for the City of Highland, Arkansas

Section 2. The position of Street Superintendent shall be filled in the manner provided by state law.


Section 3. The duties of the Street Superintendent shall be:

- A To supervise and assist with the care and maintenance of the streets, roads, avenues and right-of-ways of the City of Highland and all equipment and supplies used in this work. To be in charge of drainage and water control. To assume such other duties and responsibilities, as assigned by the mayor and/or the City Council, that relate to these areas of work.
- B To keep accurate and complete record of the equipment, supplies and materials his control. Provide for the service and maintenance of said equipment.
- C To perform such other duties as may be required by the ordinances of the City or laws of the State.


Section 4. The regular work hours shall be a forty hour work week. Additional time may be required from time to time for meetings, etc.

Section 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
