

ORDINANCE NO. 04-45

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF POLICE CHIEF
FOR THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, ARKANSAS

Whereas, the public welfare can best be realized by the establishment of the office of Police Chief,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Highland, Arkansas:

Section 1. The office Police Chief is hereby established for the City of Highland, Arkansas.


Section 2. The position of Police Chief shall be filled in the manner provided by State law.

Section 3. The duties of the Police Chief shall be:


- A To supervise and assist with the protection of life and property within the City of Highland, including but not limited to, investigations, arrests, traffic control, patrolling, working with other law enforcement agencies, drug enforcement, and public relations work.
- B To keep accurate and complete record of the equipment, supplies and materials under his/her control. Provide for the service and maintenance of said equipment.
- C To perform such other duties as may be required by the ordinances of the City or laws of the State.
- D To attend the meeting and report to the City Council at the first meeting each month.

Section 4. The regular work hours shall be dictated by the needs of the community, but not less than 40 hours per week. Additional time may be required from time to time for meetings, etc.
