Section 1, ADOPTION OF ENERGY CODE

There is hereby adopted by the City Council of Highland, Arkansas, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for energy efficient standards for new building construction, this code known as the 2011 Arkansas Energy Code, being particularly the 2011 Arkansas Energy Code edition thereof and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as are hereinafter deleted, modified, or amended, of which not less than three (3) copies of this ordinance, as well as, three (3) copies of the 2011 Arkansas Energy Code, have been and now are filed in the office of the Recorder/Treasurer of the city of Highland, Arkansas, and the same ordinance is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the date on which this ordinance shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling in the construction of all buildings and structures therein contained within the corporate limits of the City of Highland, Arkansas.

Section 2, INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED.

Ordinances or parts thereof in force at the time that this ordinance shall take effect, if inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas it is of the utmost urgency that the city of Highland, Arkansas, have an up-to-date Energy Code to protect the citizens of our city, therefore, an Emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public shall take effect immediately on its passage and approval.
