AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 04-33, AN ORDINANCE FIXING RATES FOR SERVICE RENDERED BY THE SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, ARKANSAS; ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR REQUIRED CONNECTION TO THE SEWER SYSTEM FACILITIES; AND PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST.

Section 1. ORDINANCE NO. 04-33 is amended as follows:

A NEW SECTION 1 (d) is added to the ordinance.

(d) Late payment charges. Any customer of the City of Highland, Arkansas, sewer system who does not pay the amount due for sewer services in full when billed shall be assessed a late payment charge of ten percent (10%) of the amount of the delinquent account to be added to the customer's account and collected from the customer.

<u>Section 2.</u> Emergency Clause. This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, comfort, convenience, morals, safety and welfare of the City of Highland, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
