**Whereas**, the City of Highland, Arkansas, desires to adopt by reference the current edition of the Arkansas Fire Prevention Code and the current edition of the Standard Unsafe Building Abatement Code for use within the City; and

**Whereas**, the City of Highland, Arkansas, has complied with the requirement of ACA §14-55-207 by publishing a notice of intent to adopt these technical codes by reference in a paper of general circulation within the municipality and three copies of the codes have been available for inspection at City Hall by the public prior to their adoption; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** Ordinance No. 03-28 is repealed to the extent its provisions are superseded by the provisions of this ordinance or are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** The Arkansas Fire Prevention Code is adopted by reference.

**SECTION 3.** The Standard Unsafe Building Abatement Code is adopted by reference.


**SECTION 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed to the extent of the conflict.
